- Volunteers and support. After talking with Freddie about marshals, vacant volunteer positions were discussed. Debbie Fulgoni offered to call/recruit members for the open positions.
 - Wendy shared that Dale Kelch, who has provided and managed our bird boys for many years, is retiring from this task. For our 2014 Hunt Test, the club needs a volunteer mentor with Dale to take over the responsibility for next year.
- ➢ Judge's Dinner. Luane secured M&M Italian (400 Pacheco Blvd., Los Baños) with a semi-private room for 16+ MBHRC Judge's Dinner. Members will pre-pay for their dinners and the club will pay the restaurant on one charge. With one set price, pre-selected menu items will be offered to diners in advance of the dinner. No host drinks (soda, alcohol − checking with venue about coffee). Judge's drinks will be hosted by Wendy, Lucy and Denise. Luane will draft a flier and will create tickets to designate who ordered what menu item.
 - The Italian menu choices will be meat lasagna, chicken piccata or clam linguini (white sauce) with a green salad at price of approximately \$28.50 per person.
- ➤ <u>Raffle.</u> There was further discussion regarding pre-selling A5 Raffle tickets. Pre-purchase of A5 raffle tickets is ongoing. Last month Denise talked with Michael Tancredi about the process for members who wish to sell A5 raffle tickets but prefer not to pre-pay. Denise will draft a message to send to the club regarding how to obtain tickets without pre-paying, review with Tancredi and distribute.
